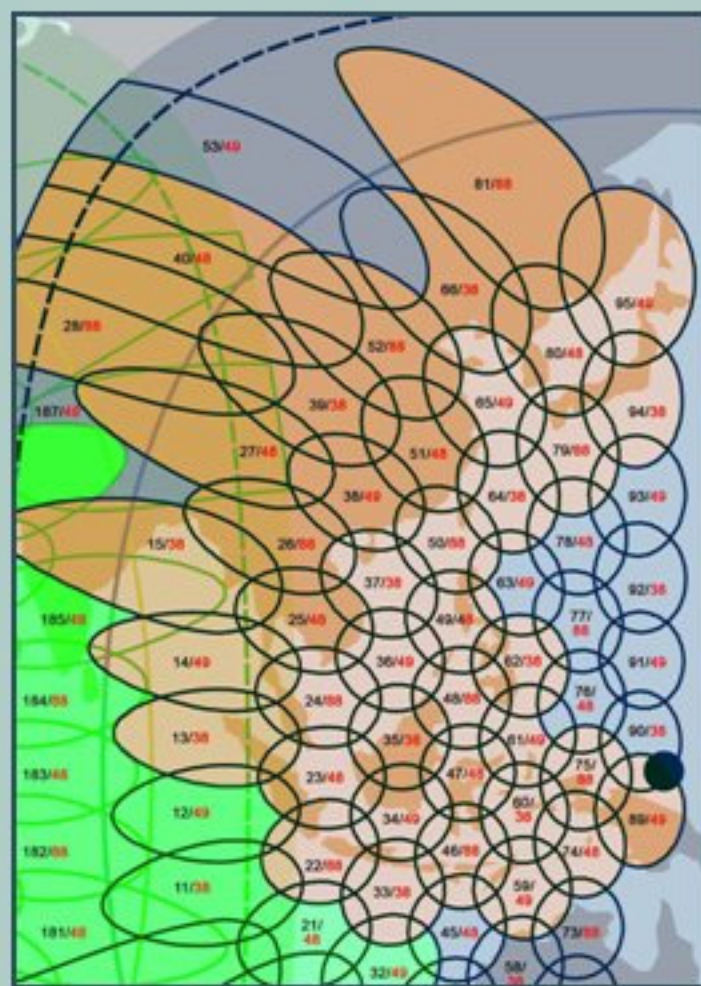

## SMART Link call rate on selected INMARSAT areas, now only P15/min.

SMART Link subscribers sailing within selected areas in the Asia-Pacific region can now use either ACeS or INMARSAT's satellite signals to call the Philippines, and still enjoy the affordable P15/min SMART Link call-home rate.

This means that subscribers in these selected areas are guaranteed of the affordable P15/min. rate, no matter what satellite signal they choose manually or even if their satphone automatically locks in to INMARSAT.



The selected areas with the reduced rates are the ones covered by the orange-shaded INMARSAT channel numbers as illustrated in the map above. Regular call rates when using INMARSAT channel numbers to call the Philippines are P30/min (Zone B) and P40/min (Zone C). Using any ACeS channel number to call the Philippines on the other hand, still offers the user the most affordable SMART Link call rate of P15/min.
