



Definition of Terms:

- Learning Activity: A Lesson Plan or Activity
- ICT-enabled Learning Activity: A lesson plan or activity where ICT is used either by the teacher or students or both.
- Learning Objective or Competency: The knowledge, skills and values that the Learning Activity is designed to achieve
- ICT Tool: A software or application that both teachers and students use during the Learning Activity.  
  
Examples of ICT tools are: Microsoft Excel for spreadsheets, Microsoft Access for data basing, Microsoft Powerpoint for presentations, Web browsers, E-mail, Blog, Search Engines, Discussion Boards or Online Messengers such as Yahoo or MSN.
- Instructional Design: The manner by which the different components of a Learning Activity such as the Learning Objectives, ICT Tools and Assessment Strategies are organized to create a seamless learning experience.
