

# How to update your handset's software


**1** Go to **Settings** then select **Software Update**


**2** Download and install the latest software version


**3** Go back to **Settings** then select **Connections > Mobile Networks**. **VoLTE** will be added in the options.





# How to enable VoLTE


Go to **Settings** then select **Connections**
